Subject Pronouns I, you, he, she, it, we, you, they

Subject Pronouns I am, you are, he is, she is, it is, we are, you are, they are.

+ to be

I'm, you're, he's, she's, it's, we're, you're, they're

| Affirmative form | | Negative form | |
|------------------|---------------|-------------------|------------------|
| I am | I'm | I am not | I'm not |
| You are | You're | You are not | You aren't |
| He is | He 's | He is not | He isn't |
| She is | She 's | She is not | She isn't |
| It is | It 's | It is not | It isn't |
| We are | We're | We are not | We aren't |
| They are | They're | They are not | They aren't |

EXAMPLES:

Affirmative sentences:

I am your friend.

He is Mexican.

You are in school.

I'm your teacher.

He's 17 years old.

You're very friendly.

Negative sentences:

I am not angry.

She is not at home. She isn't ready for the exam. She's not my sister.

We are not French. We aren't rich. We're not going to Cuba.

Questions and answers:

Are you a teenager?Yes, I am.No, I'm not.Is your father an architect?Yes, he is.No, he isn't.Am I invited to the party?Yes, you are.No, you aren't.
