



Questions with verbs in the simple present (auxiliary do)

Do/Does + Subject + Base verb

Questions and answers:

Do you read books? Yes, I do. No, I don't.

Do they watch horror movies? Yes, they do. No, they don't.

Do you like to watch TV? Yes I do.

No I don't.

Do you **like** to watch TV? Yes, I **do.** No, I **don't.**

Does Ricky **work** at night? Yes, he **does**. No, he **doesn't**.

Does she have children?Yes, she does.No, she doesn't.Does she like to listen to music?Yes, she does.No, she doesn't.

What **do** you **do** in your free time? I **play** soccer. I **go** shopping. When **does** your vacation **start**? It **starts** in July.

The Simple present tense

Affirmative sentences: Negative sentences: I like pizza. I don't like pizza.

You **live** in Guadalajara. You **don't live** in Guadalajara. He **dances** at the party. He **doesn't dance** at the party.

She eats pozole. She doesn't eat pozole.

It rains in the city. It doesn't rain in the city.

We play volleyball. We don't play volleyball.

They **work** in a factory. They **don't work** in a factory.
