	win			winning
	cut			cutting
	swim			swimming
4. Verbs ending in - ie	tie			tying
	lie			lying
	die			dying

I am / I'm not	reading	a book.
You are / You aren't	eating	a sandwich.
Johnny is / Johnny isn't	kissing	the girl.
She is / She isn't	taking	a shower.
We are / We aren't	doing	our homework.
They are / They aren't	playing	basketball.

Questions and answers:

Are you sleeping?	Yes, I am .	No, I'm not .
Is he drinking water?	Yes, he is .	No, he isn't .
Am I helping you?	Yes, you are .	No, you aren't .
